


Harvey's Trike

Harvey is 4-years old and is a happy and inquisitive little boy with an infectious laugh. He was born on 18th January 2010, six weeks early, his eagerness to join the world leaving him suffering spastic diplegia cerebral palsy, meaning he is unable to use his legs properly and cannot currently walk. In the long term, without adequate intervention, his legs will eventually become deformed and he's likely to suffer quite a bit of paint

To mitigate his condition Harvey's parents decided to raise £50,000 to give him the opportunity to have a life changing operation called selective dorsal rhizotomy performed in St Louis, Missouri, USA, which is the world's leading hospital for this operation, with over 2500 successful operations.

The operation is available on the NHS, but it's a post code lottery whether they would get funding or not with recent applications in his area having been refused.



Additionally, it often takes in excess of 18-months from referral to getting a decision on the operation on the NHS.

Harvey had the operation during June of 2013, completely removing his spasticity. He's now doing the hard work to learn to use his legs in a completely different way to what he's used to with the aim of eventually learning to walk independently in all environments. To achieve this he has physiotherapy, training and exercise regime pretty much every day.

Swanwick Lions have helped by funding a specially adapted tricycle for Harvey. This assists him in learning to use his leg properly while providing support and training to strengthen and develop his hips, at the same time as giving him a little independence and fun. He loved it from the second he saw it and is for ever asking to go on it, no matter the weather.
