Every year, 44,000 people die in the UK from this' silent killer'. It's more common than heart attacks, and kills more people than bowel, breast cancer, prostate cancer, and road deaths COMBINED. But very few people know about this condition.

Commenting on the condition, Lion President Helen said: "I suffered from sepsis last year, and know from personal experience what a dangerous condition it is, and how early diagnosis probably saved ny life"

The Trust was set up to raise awareness of sepsis, and their mission is to educate the public and healthcare professionals, and to support survivors and bereaved families.
